WINCHESTER SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Winchester City Council held special meeting July 15, 2025 at City Hall.

Bryan Cannon, presented the bids and contract for the yearly MFT Project. Two bids were received, Illinois Valley Paving for \$69,801.00 and Hood Construction for \$96,160.00. The job was granted to Illinois Valley Paving as they were lowest bid and also was under the projected cost. John Simmons will get with IVP to set up time to do work.
